



IowaMicroLoan was created by Iowans to help other Iowans realize their goal of achieving business success when they have a solid idea and the commitment to make it work. A successful business requires skills in production, financial management, and marketing. Small entrepreneurs are often great at one or maybe two of these necessary skill areas, but not all three. Our goal is to establish a statewide team of IFMCV affiliates and partners working within a county-level network to assist you in identifying the best technical assistance resources available. The assistance may range from local business mentors to regional and statewide networks (such as SBDCs, SCORE, AgMRC, ISU Extension, ISED Ventures, MyEntrenet, USDA RC&Ds, and others) to give you the targeted assistance your business needs to be successful.

Enhancing Your Future

We offer you the opportunity to start-up or expand your microbusiness and provide up to \$500 per year in technical assistance grants to assist you in your business development. IFMCV interest rates are based on 5-year U.S. Treasury Notes and are typically 2% above commercial lending prime rates. IFMCV's rate allows us to serve smaller entrepreneurial loan clients and provides incentives for technical assistance. As your business experience and risk rating factors improve, IFMCV will assist you in finding a long term home for

your future credit needs as you continue to grow and prosper in Iowa.
